

CLUB FUNDS AVAILABLE TO COMMUNITY GROUPS

Last year registered clubs in NSW supported community and sporting groups to the tune of more than \$100 million.

More than half of this support came from medium and large sized clubs who participate in the **Community Development and Support Expenditure (CDSE)** scheme.

The CDSE scheme allows registered clubs with annual gaming machine revenue exceeding \$1 million to apply 1.5% of gaming machine revenue to specific community development and support projects. At least 50% of funding from each club is to be allocated to *Category 1* projects.

Applications are now open to community groups requiring funding for programs this year. Projects in the following categories qualify for *Category 1* funding:

- Community welfare and social services
- Community development
- Community health services
- Employment assistance activities.

A Local Committee has been convened in each Council area to make funding recommendations to local CDSE clubs.

Applications for *Category 2* grants (including sporting, cultural and other activities) are administered directly by the clubs.
